## LEADERSHIP FOR LEARNING: A COURSE FOR SCHOOL LEADERS AND ASPIRING LEADERS

**A professional learning opportunity for all who seek to lead effective 21st century schools**

This inspirational and practical course will extend your leadership skills and knowledge to enable you to maximise learning for students and staff.

The program will be delivered by school principals who have had many years of experience in successful school leadership as well as leadership in the professional development of peers.

Groups of at least 15 overseas school leaders will learn collaboratively as they are led to a deeper understanding of the concept of leadership for 21st century schools and the required skills and knowledge to lead their schools to high quality student outcomes.

The program is delivered on-site in a NSW Government school and includes reading materials, on-site lectures and collaboration with leading principals from a range of successful schools. These will include Primary schools (Years K-6), Secondary schools (Years 7-12) as well as schools for children with special needs.

Program time is 30 hours per week (6 hours each day Monday to Friday) for 2 weeks and an in-school on-line support up to four hours on return to their home school. School visits and guest lectures from principals and inspiring school leaders will be included.

Participants will complete assessments during the course and an in-school assignment in their home school which will be supported in an on-line forum.

On completion of the program, all participants will be presented with a Certificate of Participation.

**Pre-requisite:** Program participants must demonstrate sufficient English language competency to participate in all program activities.

Homestay accommodation, meals and assistance with daily transfers to school can also be arranged.
